## The More You Know...

Liberty Mutual states, *"US businesses spend more than one billion dollars a week on serious, nonfatal workplace injuries."* Yes, you read that right...billion! Annually, they rank the top 10 causes of serious (nonfatal) workplace injuries by their workers compensation costs. Here is the 2021 index:

1. Overexertion involving outside sources (handling objects: lifting, pushing, pulling, carrying, etc.)
2. Falls on same level
3. Falls to lower level
4. Struck by object/equipment
5. Other exertions or bodily reactions (e.g., bending, reaching, twisting, climbing, kneeling, sitting, etc.)
6. Roadway incidents – vehicle crashes
7. Slip or trip without fall
8. Struck against object/equipment (colliding with objects)
9. Caught in or compressed by equipment/objects
10. Repetitive motions involving microtasks

Training for individuals who work in areas where asbestos containing materials (ACM) may be present, but are not disturbed in the course of their work.

Required for individuals who will investigate public or private buildings for asbestos containing materials.
